In this step-by-step planner, you'll be guided how to select, order, install, and style these panels to transform a home entrance, hallway, living room, dining area, or bedroom wall.

Discover how to apply panels across an entire room, half wall, hallway runner, banquette seat, or even create a standalone bedhead.

Panels arrive in durable, pre-primed MDF sheets that seamlessly connect via a tongue and groove system, so there's no tricky installation of individual boards. Simply paint in a colour of your choice to finish.


It's never been easier to install your own interior wall panelling. Let's get started!

Defining your style

The colours, furniture, materials, size, layout, and architectural style of your home will inform the best Surround by Laminex profile for your space. Are you looking for a classic heritage look, or a modern space with bolder accents?

Choose a colour palette

Surround by Laminex panels arrive pre-primed ready to be painted in any colour.

To arrive at your favourite shade, think about how you want the space to feel and function, as well as the existing materials in the room. Colour psychology tells us soft pastels offer a soothing effect; earth-based colours make us feel safe and cocooned; and vibrant shades of yellow, red and blue can help stimulate the mind.

DON'T BE AFPAID TO TAKE PISKS! PANELS CAN BE PAINTED MULTIPLE TIMES, PROVIDING THE FLEXIBILITY to update over time.



Create a mood board

Arrange your inspiration as a physical or digital mood board to visualise the elements of your completed space. Include images and samples of your preferred Surround by Laminex profiles, as well as paint swatches, flooring, textiles, and furniture references to bring the look together.

DECIDE HOW TO USE YOUP PANELS

Surround by Laminex panels can be applied in multiple ways, with the option to add accessories like a dado rail and hooks to finish.

Full wall

The most common use, our Surround by Laminex panels are applicable across entire walls. Create a standalone feature wall, or install across an entire room.

Half / split wall

Install panels across a half, quarter wall or cupboard to create a hallway runner or stylish interior accent. Style the remainder of the wall with a contrasting surface (like painted plasterboard for a neutral look, or timber for added texture), or a complementary Surround by Laminex profile separated by a dado rail for a polished finish.



Banquette seat

Smaller surfaces such as banquette seats are perfect for showcasing bold panel styles. Simply cut and install the product across the seat face for depth and texture.



Bedhead

12mm width panels can alternatively be applied as a bedhead or decorative ledge. To achieve this look, cut and install the product to your desired height, and use the upper edge to display artwork, ceramics and other treasured items.

Subtle profiles in the classic range apply beautifully across entire walls.


Contemporary styles showcasing narrow, more dimensional boards are ideal for creating statement surfaces or feature walls.

CHOOSE YOUR PROFILE

Surround by Laminex panels are available in a range of profiles across two ranges: classic and contemporary. Classic styles are designed with heritage schemes in mind, while the contemporary range offers scallops, dimensional stripes, bold battens, and curves for creating statement surfaces.

Experiment with bolder panels (Scallops; Batten 25) in working spaces like kitchens and dining areas, or inspire relaxation in bedrooms and living areas with curving and classic (Classic VJ; Demi Round) profiles.

The ability to paint panels any colour you choose offers the versatility to suit all interior schemes, and the flexibility to update over time.




PANELS APPIVE IN SHEETS THAT SEAMLESSLY CONNECT VIA A SIMPLE tongue and groove system

A timeless style featuring vertical boards separated by straight-edged grooves. The wider profiles are a modern take on classic timber panelling, while the narrow versions create a bold contemporary look.



The boldness of Batten 25 is highlighted by Dulux Blue Rhapsody in this moody and dramatic space.







Above Demi Round 20 is applied to a split feature wall painted Dulux Mount Buller (upper) and Dulux Snowy Mountains (lower). A dado rail separates the elegant two-tone surface.

Soft waving forms offer a calming and luxurious effect. Select a gentle wider profile or, to create more of a textural finish, choose a narrower profile.





A modern scalloped design characterised by undulating curves and contours forms a sophisticated and tactile surface. Available in a variety of widths.



A three-quarter wall application of Classic VJ 100 is applied to a classic hallway entry finished with wide skirting, a small shelf, and Dulux Snowy Mountains paint.





Heritage

An update on traditional timber panelling featuring wider boards defined by understated, curving joints. Heritage panels are designed for period houses and contemporary settings alike as a nod to tradition.






Classic VJ




PLANNING MAKES PERFECT

Carefully planning the design, order, and install of your Surround by Laminex panels is key to the DIY process. Create a schedule for a clear understanding of how long the project will take and what it will cost.

Key milestones	To do
Four weeks in advance	— Measure your wall/s

Three weeks in advance	Purchase or hire equipment requir

Two days in advance	Acclimatise panels for a minimum in the room they'll be installed
Install day	Cut, install, and paint your panels.

Measure your surface


Carefully measure the height and length of your wall or surface to calculate how many Surround panels are required.

INSIDER TIP:

Remember to allow for 10mm expansion gaps at the top and bottom of the panels when you cut them to size.


This is because MDF responds to the humidity and temperature of the surrounding environment, affecting the moisture content of the product, resulting in panel dimension change.

Wall type

Determine what surface you'll be applying panels to: timber stud walls; steel framed walls; brick; block; masonry; or plaster for the correct installation method.



INSIDER TIP:

Thoroughly read the Surround by Laminex Fabrication & Installation Manual at the start of your project to make sure you prepare and apply the panels correctly.

What you'll need

Safety glasses
Face mask
Ear protection
Safety gloves
Tape measure
Pencil
Spirit level
10mm spacers
Stud finder

Openings and cut-outs

Account for existing or planned windows, doors and openings, power outlets, switches, controls, and vents when measuring your space. Any access cut-outs must not occur less than 150mm from the edge of the panel.




Dado rails

The addition of a dado rail is recommended to finish the join between contrasting surfaces.

Here's a checklist of basics you'll need to complete the job.

Circular saw
Jigsaw
Drill, nail gun or hammer
Screws or nails
Construction adhesive
Putty & putty knife
Sanding sponge
Paint brushes
Masking tape

Check product lead times in advance to ensure everything can arrive before install day. Special orders may require additional time.



TIME TO INSTALL


It's the day you've been waiting for – getting those panels up! Follow the detailed instructions for your panels and interior surface and watch the space transform before your eyes.


The following instructions are for affixing panels to plaster only. For other surfaces, consult the Surround by Laminex Fabrication & Installation Manual.

Installation

To begin installation, start from the corner and work across the wall.

Apply a generous amount of construction adhesive in the location of each stud and noggin.





When fixing the panel to the frame, space the nails/or screws approximately 200 to 300mm apart; 50mm from the side where possible, but not less than 10mm, and no less than 10mm from the top and bottom of the panel.

Panels can be nailed by hand or nail gun or screwed into place.

A centre out pattern is recommended. If this is not achievable, fix along one side of the panel and work across.



Then position the panel on the wall.

Use spacers to ensure there is a 10mm expansion gap at the top and bottom of the panel.

Using a spirit level, ensure the sheet is accurately positioned.



The panels join using a tongue and groove system. Do not forcefully hit the sheets together.






Repeat the previous steps to complete the installation of the next panel.

To finish the installation, cut the final panel using your measurements and fix into position. Once the panels are fixed to the wall, remove the spacers.




Finishing

Use putty to fill in any nail or screw holes, allow adequate drying time before you sand and paint.

Lastly, install skirting boards, cornices and dado rails as necessary.


Texture

Accessories


Accessorise your Surround by Laminex panels with hooks and wall dots to offer storage space in mud rooms and home entrances.
